ATTACHMENT TO PERSONAL PROTECTION ORDER PETITION

- A Personal Protection Order entered on August 11, 2004 and Nunc Pro Tunc Order Amending Personal Protection Order entered on August 12, 2004 in Case No. 04-697038-PP.
 Petitioner incorporates by reference her Petition for Personal Protection Order dated 8/11/04 in that matter.
- The Personal Protection Order dated August 12, 2004 expired on February 28,
 2005.
- 3. The parties are currently married and are also parties to a pending divorce action, Case No. 04-696841-DO (the "Divorce Action").
 - 4. The parties continue to reside in the same home.
 - 5. The Divorce Action is set for trial on May 12, 2005.

- 6. The parties agreed to extend the Personal Protection through at least the date of trial and thereafter. A copy of the stipulation is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 7. The Court refused to extend the PPO by stipulation and the PPO subsequently expired.
- 8. Petitioner requests that a new PPO enter immediately because she is fearful for her safety and because the parties continue to reside together.
- When the PPO entered last August, the parties and the Court believed that the
 Divorce Action would conclude prior to February 28, 2005, the day the PPO expired.
- 10. Unfortunately, the Divorce Action has taken longer than anticipated and the parties continue to reside together.
- 11. Petitioner lives locked in the basement and Respondent lives in the master bedroom.
- 12. The PPO is needed to prevent Respondent from assaulting, attacking, molesting, wounding, following, confronting and otherwise injuring Petitioner. The PPO is also needed to prevent Respondent from prescribing or administering medication to Petitioner.
- 13. Until these parties are physically separated (and perhaps beyond), a PPO is necessary to protect Petitioner.
- 14. Petitioner believes that without the PPO, Respondent would continue to assault, attack, molest, wound, follow, confront and otherwise injure her as well as continue to prescribe and administer medication to her.
- 15. Although Petitioner believes that absent exclusive possession of the marital home, she is not safe, she only seeks continuation of the PPO as previously ordered by this Court. Accordingly, she presents a PPO in the exact form as entered by the Court on August 12, 2004.
