ORDER OF IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION

You are hereby notified that the freestanding surgical outpatient facility license of the Women's Center of Southfield is suspended immediately. This suspension is based upon a finding that a deficiency or violation of The Public Health Code or the rules promulgated under The Public Health Code seriously affects the health, safety, and welfare of individuals receiving care or services from the Women's Center of Southfield. MCL 333.20168.

The findings of the Department which support immediate suspension are as follows:


1. Failure to plan, staff, equip, and operate a facility with the individual patient's welfare and safety of paramount concern and failure to give a patient(s) feelings, sensibilities, and comfort meticulous attention. Mich. Admin Code, R 325.3825.
2. Failure to provide informed consent. Mich. Admin Code, R 325.3828.
3. Failure to provide counseling and referrals for subsequent care. Mich. Admin Code, R 325.3833.
4. Failure to establish medical staff rules, regulations, and policies. Mich. Admin Code, R 325.3836(2).
5. Nursing qualifications. Specifically, but not limited to, failing to have a qualified registered nurse present. Mich. Admin Code, R 325.3840.

6. Supplies, equipment, and processing. Specifically, but not limited to, failing to maintain a sterile facility and failing to have adequate supplies and equipment. Mich. Admin Code, R 325.3842.
7. Medical records. Specifically, but not limited to, improper charting. Mich. Admin Code, R 325.3847.

You are afforded the opportunity for a hearing on this issue, within five days of the issuance of this Order, before the Director or the Director's authorized representative. If you wish to avail yourself of this opportunity, a request must be made to the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs. MCL 333.20168(1). This request can be made to:
