Chip,

This follows our earlier telephone conversation in which you confirmed that Dr Umoren does not deny the fact that he was a Citizen of the United States of America prior to and at the time of filing the original complaint and continues to maintain his dual citizenship of Nigeria and United States of America. You also stated that Dr Umoren position is that he was a resident of California at the time of filing this complaint. As explained in my letter, the test for diversity for purposes of federal jurisdiction is domiciliary not residency. Doctor Umoren testified that he moved from California to Alabama in 2008 to take up the position of Medical Director of Planned Parenthood of Alabama. All available employment information, credit information, deposition testimony and other legal filings show that Dr Umoren was domiciled in the State of Alabama at all relevant times in this case. There is no record that after Dr Umoren left California and moved to Alabama in 2008 to take up the appointment with Planned Parenthood that he returned to California or any intention to return to California, rather, the record is replete with information of Dr Umoren's domiciliary in the State of Alabama, he gave us the Huntsville, Alabama address as the address to serve him with legal papers, he also gave us the address in Nigeria where his wife stays as another possible address to contact him, he did not give any California address. He testified that he left California in 2008.

Furthermore, with defense counsel's knowledge of Dr Umoren's dual citizenship, I am surprised and deeply concerned with the apparent omission of Dr Umoren's United States citizenship both in the consent to removal and the recently filed DISCLOSURE STATEMENT PURSUANT TO FEDERAL RULE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE 7.1 AND LOCAL RULE 3.4. Based on Dr Umoren's dual citizenship, it is clear that the Notice of Removal was at a minimum, improvidently filed. There is no federal court diversity jurisdiction.

Again, we ask that Dr Rohlfing voluntarily withdraw the removal petition filed on his behalf as requested in our 3 page letter to all parties.
