Types of Abortion:

* For any type of abortion in Wisconsin, law requires that on the first clinic visit, patients receive state mandated information, patient education, ultrasound, lab tests, and sign some paperwork. State law also requires a 24 hour wait before the patient's second visit.

<u>In-Clinic Abortion:</u> the most common type of in-clinic abortion is called a vacuum aspiration, which can usually be performed up to 16 weeks into pregnancy. *(See above for description of first clinic visit). During the second visit, the patient receives pain medication or sedation, the cervix is numbed, and the patient receives antibiotics to prevent infection, a tube is inserted through the cervix and into the uterus where a suction machine gently empties the uterus. This process takes about 5-10 minutes.

Abortion Pill: The abortion pill, called Mifepristone or RU-486 can usually be used up to 9 weeks after the first day of a woman's last period. The abortion pill is safe and effective with a 97% success rate. *(See above for description of first clinic visit). During the second visit, the patient receives both antibiotics and their first pill, which blocks progesterone so the uterine lining breaks down. A few days later, the patient will take the Misoprostol pill which causes the uterus to empty. This part may take a few hours, and feels much like cramping to some patients, but can be more painful for others. In the rare cases where the abortion pill does not work, the patient would be required to have a vacuum aspiration performed (free of charge), because the pill could cause serious birth defects should

the pregnancy be carried to term.
