Dear Doctor:

Pursuant to a random audit process, you have been selected to provide the continuing education documentation that you relied upon to complete your license renewal. According to Board records, you renewed your license for the period of October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2013. In addition, you agreed that you would maintain and produce that information to the Board upon request.

If you certified one year, **CME date 2013**, you must provide proof of 50 CME hours with a minimum of 20 hours of Category I and a maximum of 30 hours of Category II for hours earned 04/01/11 - 09/30/12. If you certified two years, **CME date 2014**, you must provide proof of 100 CME hours with minimum of 40 hours Category I and a maximum of 60 hours of Category II for hours earned 01/01/10 - 06/30/12. If you certified three years, **CME date 2015**, you must provide proof 150 hours with a minimum of 60 hours Category I and a maximum of 90 hours of Category II for hours earned 04/01/09 - 09/30/12. Enclosed please find a Continuing Medical Education Form that you may use when submitting your Category II hours or you may submit them in spreadsheet form.

Please provide copies of proof of your continuing education postdated no later than **January 4, 2013**. Failure to produce the requested information by the due date will result in a \$500.00 fine, payable within 30 days. Failure to provide the requested records will result in a **SUSPENSION** of your license.

You may mail, email or fax this information and please include a copy of this letter. Mailing, emailing and/or faxing a document does not guarantee that the information was received by the Kansas Board of Healing Arts. You will want to request a delivery confirmation to confirm your documents have been received by the Board. You may include your request for a delivery confirmation on the cover sheet of your fax or arrange a delivery confirmation through your postal service. All confirmations must come directly from the Board, or your parcel service. A fax machine transmission report will **not** be accepted as proof.

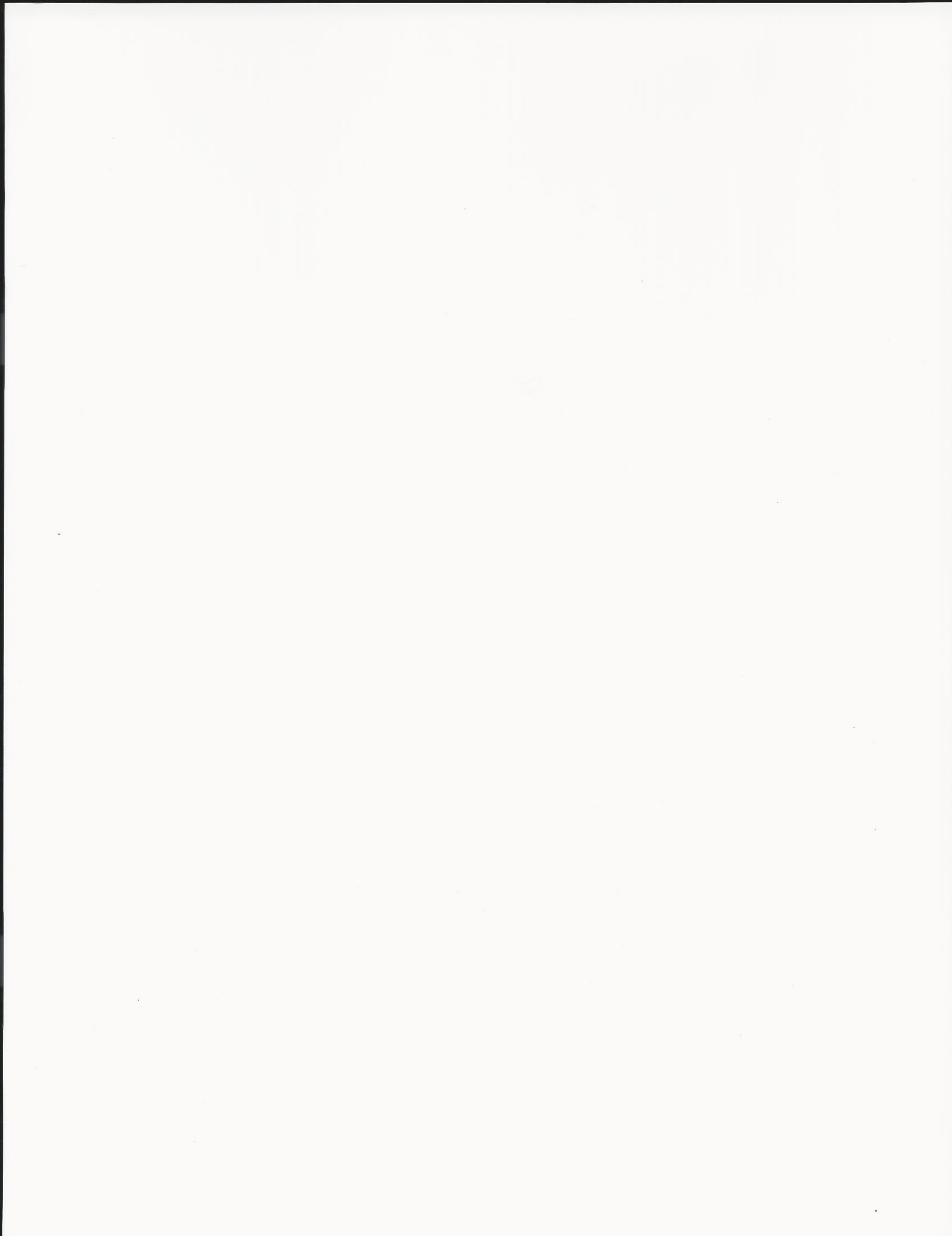

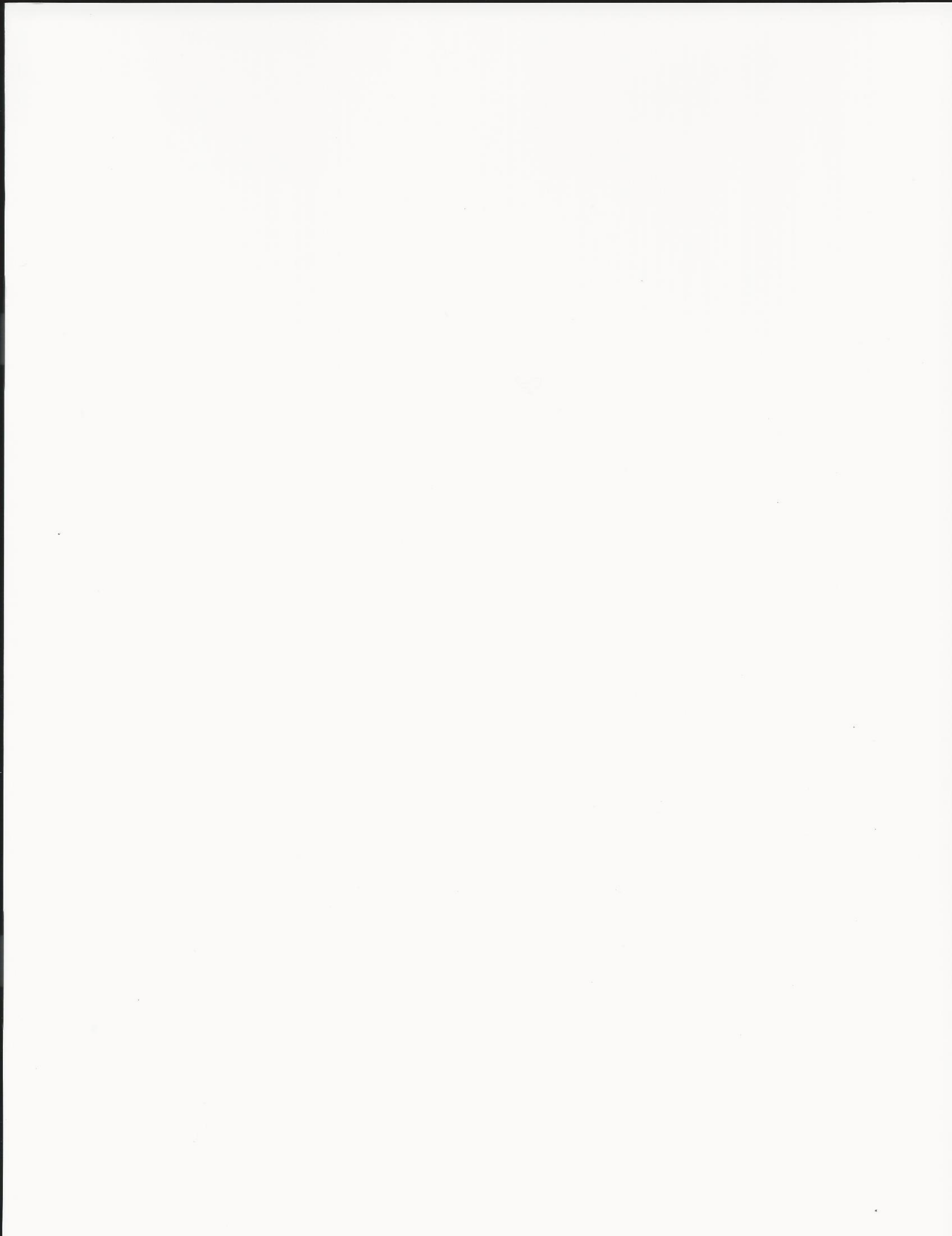
