First and foremost, we want to recognize Deborah Jackson for her humanism award given at Honors Convocation. The award is so well deserved.

Deborah M. Jackson, MSEd., Medical Student Program Coordinator, was named the 2018 recipient of the Joseph W. St. Geme, Jr., MD Award from the University of Colorado, School of Medicine.

he annual Joseph W. St. Geme, Jr., MD Award recognizes CU faculty, staff and students across the Anschutz Medical Campus who demonstrate exceptional ability in promoting the overall mission of the School of Medicine.

Deborah M. Jackson, MSEd., is a Medical Student Program Coordinator for the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at CU Anschutz, School of Medicine. Since joining the University in 2014, her versatility in administration and pedagogy has allowed the campus to use her skill sets in creating varied learning experiences for students.

As summarized by her colleague, "Deborah's gift to CU Anschutz has been to expand Women's Care didactics on Canvas, the students' learning management system, network with CU Online to recognize inclusivity of all learner styles as well as help bring awareness around inclusion and accessibility to all online learners. Deborah builds the connection between teacher and medical student beyond the clinic. She widens the learning community to embody all learning styles. She is also a mentor to fellow Medical Education Clinical Coordinators of Obstetrics and Gynecology (MEECOG) recognized by the association of Professors of Gynecology and Obstetrics (APGO).

Her interests, activities and endeavors beyond service to the university include gardening, reading and teaching adult learners.

Deborah, was accompanied by her family, friends and fellow Honor Award recipients, May 24th at the Honors Convocation hosted by the Office of Student Life at the Grand Hyatt Denver, 555 17th St, 38th Floor, Denver, CO 80202. Dr. Kristina Tocce, Deborah's lifelong mentor, presented the award and plaque to her.

Dr. Joseph W. St Geme was Dean of the University of Colorado School of Medicine from January 1985 to October 1986, just shy of 21 months. In his short tenure, he is credited with helping to transform the medical school to a modern research-oriented academic center. In 1987, the St. Geme Lectureship was established and supported by the Chancellor's Office and eight Chairs of the Departments in the School of Medicine who were recruited by Dr. St. Geme. Support was also provided by Dr. Robert Schrier, then Chair of the Department of Medicine and Dr. Frederick Battaglia, then Chair of the Department of Pediatrics. Dr. St. Geme held an academic faculty position in the Department of Pediatrics during his tenure as Dean.

We continue to appreciate faculty teaching in our curriculum. Dr. Gail Womack and Dr. Harvey Cohen have graciously agreed to staff a lunchtime conference for students on Mondays. Pathology and Radiology joined forces to create a multi-disciplinary conference in a tumor board style. Twelve medical students attended the Medical Student Meet and Greet. Thanks for all the advice to third year medical students who will be the future presidents of AUGS, SGO, SMFM, and ASRM.
