NJ Disciplinary Summary	
<p>FINAL ORDER OF DISCIPLINE filed MARCH 12, 2007. This matter was opened to the Board upon receipt of information which the Board has reviewed. On or about December 29, 2005, the North Carolina Medical Board, (North Carolina Board) filed a Consent Order reprimanding Dr. Virmani for pre-signing prescriptions. Dr. Vermani admitted and the North Carolina Board found that he pre-signed prescriptions which were prepared by the clinic's staff to be dispensed during the day to patients, per clinic protocol. Based on the foregoing findings and conclusions, on May 16, 2006, the New Jersey Board of Medical Examiners, (New Jersey Board) filed a Provisional Order of Discipline (POD) reprimanding Dr. Virmani. In response to the POD, Dr. Virmani submitted correspondence dated August 2, 2006. Dr. Virmani requested that the New Jersey Board dismiss the POD or alternatively, modify the POD to reflect his assertions that he was obligated to follow established protocol; and the North Carolina Board never defined pre-signing of prescriptions, thus making it unclear to Dr. Virmani that he was in violation of any North Carolina directives. Dr. Virmani's submissions were reviewed by the New Jersey Board, and the Board determined that further proceedings were not necessary and that no material discrepancies had been raised.
