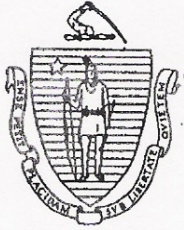


COMPLAINT AGAINST SANKEY:


Dear Ms Shea:
