ORDER AND NOTICE OF HEARING

The Arkansas State Medical Board has received information that you have been guilty of acts which would justify the revocation or suspension of your license to practice medicine in the State of Arkansas. Specifically, it has been alleged that you have been guilty of unprofessional conduct in violation of Ark. Stat. Ann. §72-613 (e) (g) and Regulation 2 of the Regulations of the Arkansas State Medical Board in that you have written prescriptions for Schedule II and IV addicting or potentially harmful drugs excessively and have written an excessive number of prescriptions for Schedule II and IV addicting or potentially harmful drugs for some persons as reflected by the attached investigative report which is incorporated herein as Exhibit A to this Notice.

You are hereby notified that a hearing will be held before the Arkansas State Medical Board on April 8, 1983, at 1:00 p.m. at the Little Rock Convention Center, Little Rock, Arkansas, at which time the Board will determine whether your license to practice medicine in the State of Arkansas should be revoked, suspended, or whether you should be subjected to any other disciplinary action. Your failure to appear before the Board will result in the immediate revocation or suspension of your license.

You are advised that you may be represented by counsel at the hearing and that you will be given the opportunity to examine all evidence offered to the Board, cross-examine witnesses, and offer evidence and witnesses in your own behalf.

This Order is issued pursuant to authority granted the Board under Ark. Stat. Ann. §§72-601 et seq. (The Arkansas Medical Practices Act) and Ark. Stat. Ann. §5-701, et seq. (The Administrative Procedure Act).
