ORDER OF FINE; GRANTING SIX MONTHS TO COMPLY WITH 201 KAR 9:310

Based upon a review of the records of the Kentucky Board of Medical Licensure (hereafter "the Board"), the Board FINDS that the licensee has failed to 1) timely complete the continuing medical education requirements of 201 KAR 9:310; and, 2) obtain an extension of time for completion of the continuing medical education requirements. Accordingly, the Board ORDERS that a FINE of FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00) is imposed against the licensee, with the fine being due and payable immediately.

Pursuant to 201 KAR 9:310, Section 7(2)(a), the licensee is GRANTED a period of six (6) months, until November 5, 2004, to come into compliance, by paying the fine imposed and by completing the continuing medical education requirements. NOTICE is hereby given that, if the licensee should fail to come into compliance within that six (6) month period, the license to practice medicine in the Commonwealth of Kentucky held by the licensee shall be immediately suspended and shall remain suspended until the licensee has submitted verifiable evidence that the licensee has completed the continuing medical education requirements.
