TERMINATION OF PROBATION

On December 3, 1997, the Board of Physician Quality Assurance (the "Board") issued a Final Order¹ and Opinion in regard to Sheo P. Sharma, M.D. (the "Respondent"). The Final Order and Opinion imposed a reprimand with certain terms and conditions of probation.

At its meeting held on September 22, 1999, the Board considered the relevant documentation reflecting the Respondent's successful compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Respondent's license to practice medicine in the State of Maryland was subject to terms and conditions of probation pursuant to the Consent Order executed on December 3, 1997
2. In accordance with the Order executed by the Board, the Respondent has complied with the terms and conditions imposed during the period of probation.
3. On September 22, 1999, the Board considered this matter and voted that the Respondent's probation be terminated.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board concludes that as a matter of law the Respondent has complied with the conditions and terms under the probationary period imposed.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is this 24th day of September, 1999,

ORDERED that the probationary period, with conditions and terms, imposed under the Final Order and Opinion is hereby **TERMINATED** and is of no further force and effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order is PUBLIC document pursuant to Maryland State Gov't Code Ann. §§10-610 et. seq.
