## ORDER OF SUMMARY SUSPENSION

An Administrative Complaint has been issued against Respondent under the Public Health Code, 1978 PA 368, as amended; MCL 333.1101 et seq, promulgated rules, and the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, as amended; MCL 24.201 et seq.

After consideration of the documentation filed in this case and consultation with the Chairperson of the Board of Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery, the Department of Community Health concludes that the public health, safety, or welfare requires emergency action, as allowed by section 16233(5) of the Public Health Code and section 92(2) of the Administrative Procedures Act.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the State of Michigan shall be summarily suspended commencing on the date this order is served.

Under 1996 AACS, R 338.1610, Respondent has the right to petition for the dissolution of this Order of Summary Suspension. Respondent may do so by filing a petition with the Department of Community Health, Administrative Tribunal, P.O. Box 30763, Lansing, Michigan 48909, with a copy to the Department of Attorney General, Licensing & Regulation Division, P.O. Box 30754, Lansing, Michigan 48909. Upon receipt of such a petition, the Administrative Tribunal will immediately schedule a hearing before an administrative law judge, who shall dissolve the Order of Summary Suspension unless sufficient evidence is produced to support a finding that the public health, safety, or welfare requires emergency action and a continuation of the suspension order.
