Dear Ms. Nowak; Since you have informed me that current status of Dr. Goyal is important, I have done some research as to his current activities. In the link above, it appears as if Dr. Goyal has recently sued Fifth-Thrid bank for renewal of a loan made to his affiliates and entities. In said lawsuit, it appears as if Dr. Goyal took out a loan for \$9 million dollars in 2003 which is the subject of the lawsuit. My concern is with the condition of the clinics which are listed as recepients of the loan as recently as last year. I have attached a copy of the Illinois Public Health Inspection reports (via a FOIA request from IDPH) from six of the seven clinics he ran in Illinois for the last several decades including A Anchor, Access, ACU, Dimensions, Forrest View and Michigan Avenue. I have also attached a copy of a complaint for a lawsuit

for non-payment of advertising services by Yellowbook against Dr. Goyal's clinics. The question for investigation is why the clinics needed the documented repairs to continue to operate (or not operate in the case of Dimensions) if Dr. Goyal was in possession of such a large loan (and was not even paying advertising expenses)? Dr. Goyal's license in Wisconsin to practice medicine and surgery was limited due to his misconduct in Illinois in the early 1990s and previous nine malpractice suits. I would like the on-line administrative order granting his limited license to be amended to show that there were actually thirteen malpractice suits prior to his being issued his license in Wisconsin and that six of his clinics in Illinois did not initially meet IDPH standards as of last year which needed to be corrected. Also I would like you to invesitigate whether or not Dr. Goyal is financially able to maintain safe clinics in the future if he loses the two lawsuits with associated substantial loss in assets. I would argue that if substantial assurances are not provided, his license to practice surgery in Wisconsin be withdrawn so that he can only practice internal medicine. Please advise me of your opinion. Respectifully submitted,

Good afternoon Mr.

I am the attorney for Wisconsin's Medical Examining Board and I have been asked to respond to your recent correspondence concerning the limited license the Board issued to Dr. Vinod K. Goyal on November 3, 2004. The Board limited Dr. Goyal's license and permitted him to practice only gynecology in Wisconsin. The order granting the license noted that by then Dr. Goyal had practiced gynecology and obstetrics for approximately thirty-two years in Illinois.

The order acknowledged that the Board was aware Dr. Goyal was subject to nine medical malpractice claims but had been relieved of liability in "at least three" of them. The Board was also aware of four complaints against Dr. Goyal's license between 1992-and 1993 related to billing practices and a 1996 reprimand for dishonest statements Dr. Goyal made to the Illinois board.

Dr. Goyal's license remains current and limited in Wisconsin. He has never been the subject of a complaint here, nor has he been disciplined. I did look at his credentials in Illinois and he has not been disciplined in that jurisdiction since 1997.

You write because you believe that there were additional medical malpractice claims against Dr. Goyal. You allege that the claims arose in 1998, 1999, 2003 and 2003. You previously contacted our credentialing office and asked to review the original application file to determine whether or not Dr. Goyal accurately reported the malpractice actions. You were told that the application file could not be located any longer. You now ask that the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board whether it is significant if Dr. Goyal did not disclose all malpractice actions against him; you also ask the Board to formally reconsider the license of Dr. Goyal.

In reviewing your correspondence, Dr. Goyal's record at the Department, and the records of the Illinois regulatory authorities, I have concluded there is no legal basis by which the Board could or should review this license. First, the only way to limit or sanction the license any further is through the disciplinary process. In other words, we need evidence of a current violation that justifies the Board's intervention. There is no legal authority that permits a citizen to request review of a seven-year-old license without evidence of a suspected and current violation. Second, whether or not Dr. Goyal accurately conveyed each and every malpractice

action at the time of his application, the Board knew he had nine claims filed against his license. They nevertheless issued a license but limited it, presumably to address quality of care concerns. The claims you allege were not reported all predate issuance of the license and for practical purposes any issue that existed in 2004, is now moot. You present insufficient evidence to justify reconsideration of a license that has been in place without issue for more than seven years. In this case, of course, we do not have evidence that Dr. Goyal did not disclose the specific claims you discuss.

I am sorry I cannot be of more help to you, but I determined that there is no legal basis to do as you ask. If you obtain evidence that Dr. Goyal is currently violating Wisconsin law, please contact us with pertinent information.



Call MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER Help!

Vijay and Vinod Goyal (collectively, "the Goyals"), who are both physicians and owners of various businesses, filed this lawsuit after their long-standing lending relationship with Fifth Third Bank ("Fifth Third") soured. The Goyals and their business entities contend that Fifth Third and loan officer Michael Kozak (collectively, "Defendants") forced a technical default on one of their loans because of their Indian ancestry and the fact that certain of their businesses perform abortions. In their 10-count amended complaint, the Goyals and their various businesses seek to recover for: (1) discrimination and retaliation under 42 U.S.C. § 1981 (Count I); (2) discrimination and retaliation under the Equal Credit Opportunity Act ("ECOA"), 15 U.S.C. § 1691(a)(1-3) (Count II); (3) a failure to provide a statement explaining the revocation of credit, as required by the ECOA, 15 U.S.C. § 1691(d) (Count III); (4) violation of the Illinois Fairness in Lending Act ("IFLA"), 815 ILCS 120/3 (Count IV); (5) breach of the revolving note for Plaintiff A.H. Employee Company Ltd. ("A.H. Note") (Count V); (6) breach of contract based on the defaults that were triggered by the default of the A.H. Note (Count VI); (7) promissory estoppel (Count VII); (8) intentional misrepresentation (Count VIII); (9)
