

chair for the last 4-5 years. This is the favorite part of my job right now. I decreased my clinical work in order to become a board member of the Chesapeake IRB.

Having been here for 14 years, I've had a variety of roles, including director of family planning. During the time I've been here, the practices have changed congruent with changes in the field, the number of patients has increased, and the variety and scope of teaching for resident staff has increased. One of the most rewarding parts of this position has been the directorship of the family planning fellowship, which provides post-graduate training in clinical work and research to post-residency doctors. Of late I have been spending the bulk of my time on research. Most, but not all, of the research is clinical and includes some industry studies, as well as many investigator-initiated projects. I have been the key person to assist both fellows and residents through their research projects and publications.

I began a research program which produced some work that is still being quoted. While I was there I was the regional medical representative to the Medical Directors Council (officer) and the National Medical Committee.

I created a liaison between Westchester County Medical Center and Planned Parenthood of Westchester/Rockland (now called PP Hudson Peconic), so that patients could be appropriately referred in both directions. Upgraded teaching programs for the residents in general gynecology

I did everything! Worked in an inner city hospital with a midwifery service, later entered a collaborative practice with 3 midwives and another obstetrician. I reorganized the outpatient gynecology and family planning services at Montefiore Hospital, and then moved over to the Einstein Hospital and the outpatient family planning service there. I worked in a high-volume out-of-hospital surgical center. In my spare time I acquired a masters in public health, started some research projects, and got my sons off to grade school.
