ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs

(Complainant) by Carole H. Engle, Director, Bureau of Health Care Services, files this

complaint against Ronald A. Nichols, M.D. (Respondent) as follows:

The Michigan Board of Medicine (Board) is an administrative 1.

agency established by the Public Health Code, 1978 PA 368, as amended; MCL

333.1101 et seg. Pursuant to section 16226 of the Public Health Code, supra, the

Board's Disciplinary Subcommittee is empowered to discipline licensees for violations of

the Public Health Code.

2. Respondent is currently licensed to practice medicine in the state of

Michigan.

On April 21, 2010, the Board's Disciplinary Subcommittee executed 3.

a Consent Order and Stipulation which fined Respondent \$10,000.00 and required

Respondent to complete 100 hours of community service.

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- 4. On March 15, 2012, the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation executed a <u>Consent Order</u> which issued Respondent an Illinois Physician and Surgeon License with a Reprimand. The adverse action was based on the April 21, 2010 disciplinary action in the state of Michigan. A copy of the Illinois <u>Consent Order</u>, marked Exhibit A, is attached and incorporated.
- Respondent failed to notify Complainant of the adverse action by the state of Illinois within 30 days of the date of the action.

COUNT I

The adverse action in the state of Illinois, as set forth above, constitutes a final adverse administrative action by a licensure, registration, disciplinary, or certification board involving the holder of, or an applicant for, a license or registration regulated by another state or a territory of the United States, in violation of section 16221(b)(x) of the Public Health Code, supra.

COUNT II

Respondent's conduct, as set forth above, evidences a failure to notify Complainant of the disciplinary action in the state of Illinois, as required by section 16222(4) of the Public Health Code, <u>supra</u>, in violation of section 16221(f) of the Public Health Code, <u>supra</u>.

This Complaint is based upon files and records maintained by Complainant and the attached Affidavit of Elaine M. Riley.

Complainant requests that the within Complaint be served upon

Respondent and that Respondent be offered an opportunity to show compliance with all

lawful requirements for retention of the license. If compliance is not shown,

Complainant further requests that formal proceedings be commenced pursuant to the

Public Health Code, rules promulgated thereunder, and the Administrative Procedures

Act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, as amended; MCL 24.201 et seq.

Pursuant to section 16231(8) of the Public Health Code, supra.

Respondent has 30 days from the date of receipt of this complaint to submit a written

response to the allegations contained herein. The written response shall be submitted

to Complainant, Carole H. Engle, Director, Bureau of Health Care Services, Department

of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, P.O. Box 30670, Lansing, MI 48909.

Pursuant to section 16231(9) of the Public Health Code, supra,

Respondent's failure to submit a written response within 30 days, as noted above, shall

be treated as an admission of the allegations contained herein and shall result in

transmittal of this Complaint directly to the Board's Disciplinary Subcommittee for

imposition of an appropriate sanction.

CONSENT ORDER

The Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois, Division of Professional Regulation by Vladimir Lozovskiy, one of its attorneys, and Ronald A. Nichols, M.D., Applicant, hereby agree to the following:

STIPULATIONS

The Applicant has made application for issuance of a Physician and Surgeon License in the State of Illinois. At all times material to the matter set forth in this Consent Order, the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois had jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties herein.

The Department is in receipt of information that in April 2010, Applicant was disciplined by the State of Michigan, Board of Medicine for his alleged negligence in care and treatment of one of his patients. (See the attached Department's Exhibit A: The State of Michigan, Board of Medicine, Consent Order, Stipulation and the Complaint Case No. 43-08-109430). The allegations set, if proven to be true, would constitute grounds for suspending, revoking and other discipline of Respondent's license on authority of 225 ILCS 60/22(A)(12).

On March 14, 2012, Applicant appeared in person in front the Illinois Medical Licensing Board. Applicant provided evidence and supporting testimony regarding

Michigan disciplinary history. Moreover, Applicant provided information regarding his current practice status and his plans for Illinois.

Applicant has been advised of the right to a hearing, the right to contest denial of his application for license, and the right to administrative review of any Order resulting from a hearing. Applicant knowingly waives each of these rights, as well as any right to administrative review of this Consent Order.

Applicant and the Department have agreed, in order to resolve this matter, that Ronald A. Nichols, M.D., be permitted to enter into a Consent Order with the Department, providing for the imposition of measures which are fair and equitable in the circumstances and which are consistent with the best interest of the people of the State of Illinois.

CONDITIONS

WHEREFORE, the Department, through Vladimir Lozovskiy, its attorney, and Ronald A. Nichols, M.D., Applicant, agree:

- A. Ronald A. Nichols, M.D., Illinois Physician and Surgeon License shall be issued with the Reprimand;
- B. This Consent Order shall become effective immediately after it is approved by the Director of the Division of Professional Regulation.
