- 3. On information and belief, the Defendant, Planned Parenthood League of Massachusetts, Inc. is a corporation duly organized and existing in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
- 4. On information and belief, the Defendant, Natalia Shcherbina, is and was at all relevant times a Citizen of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
- 5. On information and belief, the Defendant, Osama Nil, is and was at all relevant times a Citizen of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
- 6. On or about January 20, 2012, Natalia Shcherbina, was involved in an automobile accident while operating a motor vehicle registered to Osama Nil on Beacon Street in the City of Boston and pursuant to G. L. c. 231, §85A, Osama Nil is legally responsible for the negligent conduct of Natalia Shcherbina.
- 7. On or about January 20, 2012, Diane Luby was involved in an automobile accident while

- operating a motor vehicle registered to Planned Parenthood League of Massachusetts, Inc. on Beacon Street in the City of Boston and pursuant to G. L. c. 231, §85A, Planned Parenthood League of Massachusetts, Inc. is legally responsible for the negligent conduct of Diane Luby.
- 8. At all relevant times, Beacon Street in the City of Boston, County of Suffolk was a public way within the meaning of G. L. c. 90, §1.

COUNT ONE

CLAIM OF THE PLAINTIFF, TANIA HENRY, AGAINST THE DEFENDANT, DIANE LUBY, FOR PERSONAL INJURIES PREDICATED UPON NEGLIGENCE

- 9. Pursuant to Mass. R. Civ P. 10(c), 371 Mass. 909(1977), the Plaintiff adopts by reference ¶1-8 above.
- 10. On or about January 20, 2012, Defendant Diane Luby was involved in an automobile accident while operating a motor vehicle registered to Planned Parenthood League of Massachusetts, Inc. on Beacon Street, a public way, in the City of Boston.
- 11. While operating a motor vehicle on a public way on January 20, 2012 the Defendant Luby had a legal duty to operate the vehicle in a reasonable manner which she breached on the same day by negligently causing the vehicle she was operating to strike the Plaintiff's car.
- 12. The Plaintiff suffered serious personal injuries as a result of Defendant Luby's negligent operation for which damages are now being sought and demanded.

COUNT TWO

CLAIM OF THE PLAINTIFF, TANIA HENRY, AGAINST THE DEFENDANT, PLANNED PARENTHOOD LEAGUE OF MASSACHUSETTS, INC. FOR PERSONAL INJURIES PREDICATED UPON NEGLIGENCE

- 13. Pursuant to Mass. R. Civ P. 10(c), 371 Mass. 909(1977), the Plaintiff adopts by reference ¶1-12 above.
- 14. Pursuant to G. L. c. 231, §85A, the Defendant Parenthood League of Massachusetts, Inc. is legally responsible for the negligent conduct of Diane Luby.

COUNT THREE

CLAIM OF THE PLAINTIFF, TANIA HENRY, AGAINST THE DEFENDANT, NATALIA SHCHERBINA FOR PERSONAL INJURIES PREDICATED UPON NEGLIGENCE

- 15. On or about January 20, 2012, Defendant Natalia Shcherbina was involved in an automobile accident while operating a motor vehicle registered to Osama Nil on Beacon Street, a public way, in the City of Boston.
- 16. While operating a motor vehicle on a public way on January 20, 2012 the Defendant Natalia Shcherbina had a legal duty to operate the vehicle in a reasonable manner which she breached on the same day by negligently causing the vehicle she was operating to strike another vehicle and cause injury to the Plaintiff.
- 17. The Plaintiff suffered serious personal injuries as a result of Defendant Natalia Shcherbina's negligent operation for which damages are now being sought and demanded.

COUNT FOUR

<u>CLAIM OF THE PLAINTIFF, TANIA HENRY, AGAINST THE DEFENDANT, OSAMA</u> <u>NIL FOR PERSONAL INJURIES PREDICATED UPON NEGLIGENCE</u>

- 18. Pursuant to Mass. R. Civ P. 10(c), 371 Mass. 909(1977), the Plaintiff adopts by reference ¶¶1-12 & 15-17.
- 19. Pursuant to G. L. c. 231, § 85A, the defendant Osama Nil is legally responsible for the negligent conduct of Defendant Natalia Shcherbina.
- 20. As a direct and proximate result of the negligence of all defendants the Plaintiff was caused to suffer severe personal injuries, incurred pain and suffering, loss of earning capacity and incurred medical bills and other costs for which the defendants are jointly and severally liable.

Wherefore, Plaintiff prays that judgment be entered against each Defendant Operator and Defendant Owner in an amount that will fairly and adequately compensate for Plaintiff's conscious pain and suffering and all other damages recoverable under Massachusetts law together with interest, costs and such other relief as this Honorable Court may deem appropriate.

JURY DEMAND

Plaintiff hereby demands a trial by jury on each claim asserted or hereafter asserted in the

Complaint, and on each defense asserted or hereafter asserted by any Defendant.
