Chief Complaint: vaginal bleeding

HPI: _____ is a 37 year old _____ who is being admitted for observation after vaginal bleeding after a D&E for a 16 week fetus. The patient had initially an uncomplicated D&E after cervical dilation 24 hours before with dilapam and 400mcg cytotec PV. After the procedure she began to have bleeding and a posterior fibroid in the lower uterine segment was palpated. She lost about 1000 cc of blood. She was given 20 units of ptiocin IV, 0.2mg of methergine, 20 units of vasopressin injected into the cervix, and 10cc of monsels. Her bleeding stopped and her vitals were stable. She was set to the ER for evaluation and admission for observation to MVH.

In the ER she initially went to the bathroom and had a BM without difficulty. However, on a second trip to the bathroom she started to faint, and was caught by a nurse and attendant. She was gently placed on the ground. The patient never lost consciousness or had any trauma. She was then placed on her bed for an exam. The patient reports severe cramping.
