The regularly scheduled meeting of the NH Board of Registration in Medicine was held on Thursday, January 7, 1982 beginning at 9 A.M.

First order of business was election of President and other officers of the Board. The vote was unanimous to reelect Stuart W. Russell, M.D., President; Samuel C. May, M.D., Vice President and Hugh Fairley, M.D., Secretary.

Present were: Stuart W. Russell, M.D., Samuel C. May, M.D., Stephen A. Tzianabos, M.D., Hugh F. Fairley, M.D., John S. Perley, Public Member and William T. Wallace, Jr., M.D., M.P.H., Executive Secretary.

Review of information received from Dan Jones, Kiniseotherapist and given to Dr. Russell for review was discussed. The Board does not feel that he is practicing medicine. Does his own hand's on treatment. It is not PT because he does not apply modalities of PT (no passive exercises). Might be cross between physical therapy and a trainer. There is a need to look into the whole matter of health professional regulation. Dr. Wallace is to talk about it with Representative Sara Townsend.

Howell, A. Ervin, M.D. Appeared before full board for personal interview. Has been offered job with Portsmouth Rehabilitation Center doing evaluations and examinations. His present practice does not keep him very busy so looks for better opportunities. Dr. Albright is orthopedic specialist in Portsmouth area. He was questioned as to what procedures he planned to do. Does not plan to apply for privileges at Portsmouth Hospital. The Board plans to contact the State of Maine board for their input into the doctor's competence and any other information they may wish to offer. The chief of staff in orthopedics will also be contacted at Sanford, Me. and York, Me. hospitals before final decision can be made as to the granting of licensure. Board voted to grant licensure by endorsement of Minesota Board exam pending results of telephone calls and contacts indicated above. If information received meets the requirements, licensure may be granted. Specialty orthopedic surgery/not board certified.

Godin, Nicole, M.D. Born 1933, France. Has ECFMG. Specialty IM. Plans for Wentworth Douglass Hospital, Dover, NH. Appeared before Board for full interview. Husband stationed at Pease Air Force Base and is also physician applying for licensure. Eventually plans to open private practice, but is presently looking for opportunities to join group practice. Board voted to grant licensure by unanimous vote with endorsement of Wisconsin exam.

Pedicino, Joseph Frank, M.D. Appeared before Board for interview. Specialty Otorhinolaryngology/Bd. Certified. Plans for Salem, NH. Motion made by unanimous vote to grant licensure by endorsement of FLEX.

Green, David, M.D. Letter sent 12/9/81 by certified mail advising him that he must supply patient records or be subject to disciplinary action. Reply had not been received up to the time of the meeting. *However, a telegram was called in at 3:10 P.M. taking exception to the Board's allegations. The Board had planned to call him in to be disciplined at the February meeting.

It was determined that a quorum of members would not be available for the meeting scheduled for February 4. The meeting was rescheduled for February 8th.

Morin, Robert, M.D. Complaint from Mr. & Mrs. Robert Stevens on behalf of Mrs. Stevens' sister who is now deceased and was patient of Dr. Morin. Reviewed by Board. A letter is to be send asking Dr. Morin for office records on this patient and for the name of his consultant in the case. Mr. & Mrs. Stevens are to be advised that the Board plans to investigate.

Lipin, Robert Gary, M.D. Licensure granted by unassembled vote ratified.

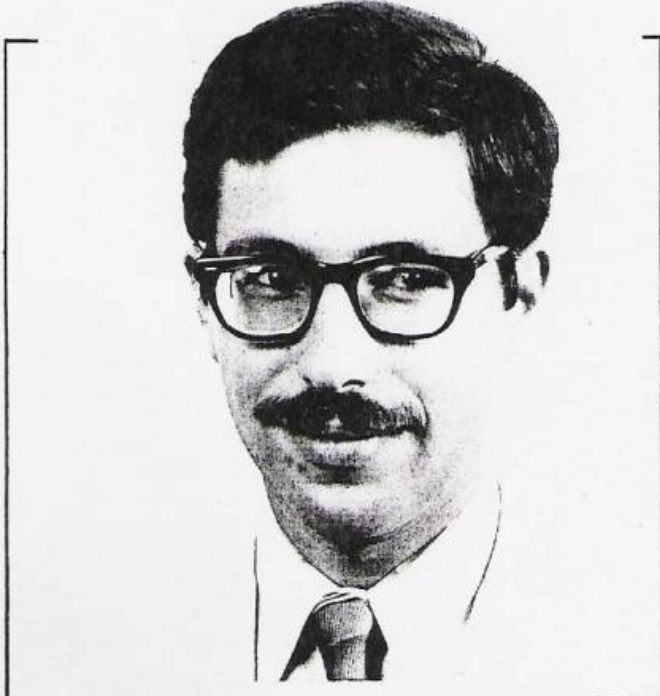
