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COMPLAINT

COMMENT: Stone vs Mair C - 97 - 277

Brenda Stone, Plaintiff, by her attorneys, Beverly A. Wallace and Breger, Kerr, @3/19/97 1:17m
Wallace & Dantes, sues David O'Neil M.D., Defendant, and states:

- 1. That Plaintiff is a resident of Baltimore County;
- 2. That Defendant is a resident of Baltimore County;
- 3. That Defendant, at all times relevant, was a licensed physician practicing in and providing medical care and treatment and other related services in Baltimore County, Maryland;

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- That on or about December 17, 1995 Plaintiff became employed as a medical assistant in the Obstetrical/Gynecological medical practice owned and operated by Defendant at 17 Fontana Lane;
- That Plaintiff was employed on an at will basis and did not have a written employment contract or a specific term of employment with Defendant;
- 6. That Plaintiff earned Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000.00) per year as a medical assistant and was entitled to bonuses and other remuneration;
 - 7. That, beginning on or about February 1, 1996, Defendant began engaging

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in a pattern of behavior both in and out of the presence of third parties intended to intimidate, embarrass, and humiliate plaintiff, consisting of, inter alia:

- a. Making remarks about the size and shape of Plaintiff's breasts;
- b. Making remarks comparing the size and shape of Plaintiff's breasts to the breasts of the unclothed and unconscious patients in the medical practice;
- c. Making remarks and asking questions about the sexual practices and habits of Plaintiff;
 - d. Licking his finger and then attempting to place it in Plaintiff's mouth; and
 - e. Relaying information about his personal sexual life, to wit:
 - i. Informing Plaintiff that he was taking the antidepressant Prozac;
 - ii. Complaining to Plaintiff that taking Prozac was lessening his libido;
- iii. Bragging to Plaintiff that, although his libido had decreased, he was able to sustain an erection for longer periods of time;
- 8. On or about May 30, 1997, Defendant summoned Plaintiff into his office and instructed Plaintiff to close her eyes, breathe deeply through her nose, and identify a particular smell;
 - 9. Plaintiff followed Defendant's directions and detected a pungent smell;
- 10. Upon opening her eyes, Plaintiff discovered that Defendant had ejaculated into a specimen container and placed the open container under her nose;
- 11. Plaintiff immediately reported the incident to the acting administrator, Debbie Riesler and then to the office administrator, Barbara Boyd;
- 12. Defendant kept the container containing his ejaculate on the floor of his office for a two week period after the incident;

13. Plaintiff sought and obtained new employment, leaving the Defendant's employ on or about August 31, 1996.

His effective and the medical particle <mark>COUNT 1 - ASSAULT</mark> (12. 14.58) in the country

- 14. Plaintiff hereby incorporates by reference and realleges paragraphs 1through 13;
 - 15. On the day Defendant placed a specimen cup under the nose of Plaintiff,
 Plaintiff was placed in fear of an offensive contact;
 - 16. Defendant acted with the intent and capability to harm Plaintiff; and
 - 17. Defendant's actions caused Plaintiff to be put in reasonable apprehension of an imminent battery; and
 - 18. As a result of Defendant's conduct and actions, Plaintiff has suffered and will continue to suffer severe mental anguish, medical and other expenses, and loss of income.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff demands judgment against Defendant for the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) in compensatory damages and One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) in punitive damages, with interest and costs.

COUNT II - INTENTIONAL INFLICTION OF EMOTIONAL DISTRESS

- 19. Plaintiff hereby incorporates by reference and realleges paragraphs 1 through 13;
- 20. Defendant's conduct was intentional, reckless, and in deliberate disregard of a high degree of probability that emotional distress would result to the Plaintiff;
- 21. The aforesaid conduct by Defendant was extreme and outrageous and beyond the bounds of decency in society; and

22. As a result of the aforesaid conduct and actions, the Plaintiff has suffered, and will continue to suffer, severe and extreme emotional distress.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff demands judgment against Defendant for compensatory damages in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) and punitive damages in the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), plus interest and the costs of this action.

COUNT III - CONSTRUCTIVE WRONGFUL TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT

- 23. Plaintiff hereby incorporates by reference and realleges paragraphs 1 through 13;
 - 24. Defendant's conduct was of a sexual nature;
- 25. Defendant's conduct and actions constituted a pattern of behavior intended to cause the Plaintiff discomfort;
- 26. Defendant's unwelcome conduct was sufficiently severe and pervasive to alter Plaintiff's conditions of employment and to create an abusive working environment:
- 27. The sole basis for the termination of Plaintiff's employment was her discomfort around Defendant;
- 28. The avowed public policy of the State of Maryland is to discourage patterns of sexual harassment as defined by Title 42 U.S.C §2000e et seq.;
- 29. As a result of the constructive wrongful termination of Plaintiff, she has been forced to accept employment at a lower salary, lost benefits and other remuneration, and has otherwise been damaged.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff demands judgment against Defendant in the sum of Two

Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) in compensatory damages and One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) in punitive damages, with interest and costs.
