FINAL ORDER

Having reviewed the Notice of Intent to Impose Late Fine dated January 5, 2009, and all other matters of record, the Agency for Health Care Administration finds and concludes as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On January 5, 2009, the Agency issued a Notice of Intent against the Respondent, A-1 Woman'S Health Care, Inc., an Abortion Clinic. The Notice of Intent is attached hereto and incorporated herein (Exhibit 1). The findings of fact and law set forth in Exhibit 1 are adopted.
2. The Respondent was served the Notice of Intent on January 8, 2009, by U.S. Certified Mail, return receipt requested. (Exhibit 2)
3. Enclosed with the Notice of Intent was an Election of Rights form, which advised Respondent of its right to a hearing pursuant to Section 120.57(1) or 120.57(2), Florida Statutes. The Respondent selected Option (1), admitting the allegations of fact and law contained in the Notice of Intent and expressly waiving the right to a hearing on the Election of Rights form (Exhibit 3)

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. The Respondent is subject to the Agency's jurisdiction pursuant to the provisions of Florida Statutes.

5. The Agency may assess an administrative against the Respondent as stated in the Notice of Intent.


Based on the foregoing findings of fact and conclusions of law, it is
