**ORDER FOR SURRENDER OF
LICENSE AND CONSENT TO THE
SAME**

(Non-Disciplinary)

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9 David L. Child, M.D. ("Physician") elects to permanently waive any right to a hearing
10 and appeal with respect to this Order for Surrender of License; admits the jurisdiction of
11 the Arizona Medical Board ("Board"); and consents to the entry of this Order by the Board.

12 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

13 1. The Board is the duly constituted authority for the regulation and control of
14 the practice of allopathic medicine in the State of Arizona.

15 2. Physician is the holder of License No. 6275 for the practice of allopathic
16 medicine in the State of Arizona.

17 3. Physician has informed the Board he is no longer able to practice medicine
18 due to a physical disability and has retired from the practice of medicine. Physician
19 requested the Board accept the surrender of her license.

20 4. There has been no finding of unprofessional conduct against Physician.

21 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

22 1. The Board possesses jurisdiction over the subject matter hereof and over
23 Respondent.

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1 5. All admissions made by Physician are solely for final disposition of this
2 matter and any subsequent related administrative proceedings or civil litigation involving
3 the Board and Physician. Therefore, said admissions by Physician are not intended or
4 made for any other use, such as in the context of another state or federal government
5 regulatory agency proceeding, civil or criminal court proceeding, in the State of Arizona or
6 any other state or federal court.

7 6. Upon signing this agreement, and returning this document (or a copy
8 thereof) to the Board's Executive Director, Physician may not revoke the consent to the
9 entry of the Order. Physician may not make any modifications to the document. Any
10 modifications to this original document are ineffective and void unless mutually approved
11 by the parties.

12 7. This Order is a public record that will be publicly disseminated as a formal
13 non-disciplinary action of the Board and will be reported to the National Practitioner's Data
14 Bank and will be reported on the Board's web site as a non-disciplinary action.

15 8. If any part of the Order is later declared void or otherwise unenforceable, the
16 remainder of the Order in its entirety shall remain in force and effect.

17 9. If the Board does not adopt this Order, Respondent will not assert as a
18 defense that the Board's consideration of the Order constitutes bias, prejudice,
19 prejudgment or other similar defense.
