

Audit: Medicaid overpaid 8 family planning clinics

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MADISON, Wis. -

The state Department of Health Services has determined that Medicaid overpaid eight family planning clinics by about \$63,800 in 2014.

The agency issued a news release Wednesday saying the its inspector general's office notified the clinics of the audit in October 2015 and visited the clinics the following month to collect documents. The audit found a number of discrepancies, including prescriptions not signed by a valid prescriber, quantities billed not matching prescription quantities and reimbursements in excess of what is allowed. Out of \$131,543 of Medicaid payments, \$63,813 were

overpayments.

The clinics included Planned Parenthood facilities in Appleton, Green Bay, Madison and Milwaukee. A Planned Parenthood spokeswoman didn't immediately return a message.

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
