Pursuant to a random audit process, you have been selected to provide the continuing education documentation that you relied upon to complete your license renewal. Failure to produce the requested information by the due date will result in a **\$500.00 fine**, payable within 30 days. Failure to provide the requested records will result in a **SUSPENSION** of your license.

Mailing and/or faxing a document does not guarantee that the information was received by the Kansas Board of Healing Arts. You may request a faxed or emailed delivery confirmation to confirm your documents have been received by the Board. You may include your request for a delivery confirmation on the cover sheet of your fax or arrange a delivery confirmation through your parcel service. All confirmations must come directly from the Board, or your parcel service, a fax machine transmission report will not be accepted as proof.

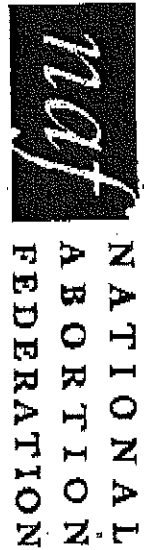

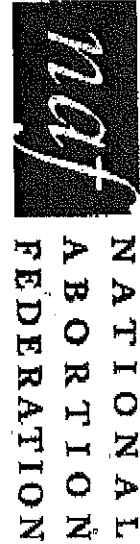
