The conviction of Oklahoma City resident Dr. John Hamilton in the 2001 Valentine's Day murder of his wife Susan Hamilton will be examined on ["True Crime with Aphrodite Jones"](#) in an episode titled "Loved to Death," airing at 9 p.m. Monday on Investigation Discovery.

A summary of the program provided by Investigation Discovery, is as follows:

Dr. John Hamilton, a respected OB/GYN in Oklahoma City, comes home between surgeries on Valentine's Day to give his wife a card. Instead, he finds her body on the floor of their bedroom, brutally beaten to death. The Hamiltons were known for running an abortion clinic – and had received many death threats. Could the perp be someone hoping to shut them down, or is there something even more sinister at work? Aphrodite Jones explores one of the most disturbing murder cases of her career of a doctor who loved his wife...to death.

In addition to the actual 9-1-1 call placed by John Hamilton and interviews with law enforcement who worked on the crime, Aphrodite interviews Steve and Mike Shibley, Susan's brothers, who have never spoken publicly about Susan's murder until now.
