9 NOTICE OF INTENT TO SELL EQUITY IN ASSETS

10 NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Trustee, John W. Reger, has filed this
11 NOTICE OF INTENT TO SELL EQUITY IN ASSETS in the above-entitled
12 proceeding.

13 Grounds: The Trustee has determined that potential non-exemptable
14 equity exists in debtors' business goodwill and condo in Hawaii. The
15 debtors wish to retain equity in this asset and are willing to buy back
16 the equity for \$2500.00 at the rate of \$250.00 per month for 10 months.

23 96002. ANY objections to the Trustee's Intent must be filed on or
24 before February 22, 2011. If an objection is filed, a Court hearing
25 will be heard before the Honorable Christopher M . Klein, Bankruptcy
Judge. The hearing would be held in Sacramento, California and you will

1 be advised of the date and time to appear. If there are no objections,
2 the agreement will be approved.

3 Local Rule 9014 of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the
4 Eastern District of California prescribes the procedures to be followed
5 and any objections to the requested relief, or a request for hearing on
6 this matter must be filed and served on the undersigned within twenty
7 one days from the mailing of this notice.

8 Furthermore, the request for hearing or objection must be
9 accompanied by any declarations or memoranda of law that the party
10 objecting or requesting wishes to present in support of its position.
11 If there is not a timely objection to the proposed sale, or a request
12 for hearing, the Trustee will file his Report of Sale with the Court.

13 Not all information on file with the Court in this case or set forth
14 in the motion is set forth in this notice, and any interested party
15 desiring further particulars, may review the Court's file in this case
16 or the motion, at the Office of the Clerk, U.S. Courthouse, 501 I
17 Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.
