



IN RE: Reporting of continuing Medical Education requirements

Dear Mr Jimison:

We have had several conversations during the past weeks concerning my CME reporting for the years 2002-2004 and I understood that, according to the records seen by the Board, I had insufficient hours in *both* Categories One and Two to allow me to renew my North Carolina medical license.

Last week, when I sent my packet of newly-updated CME hours, I had mistakenly assumed the reporting period to be the years 2003 – 2005, when in fact it was 2002 – 2004 an error you informed me of in a telephone call on 2/6/06. During that conversation, you calculated that although I had not even reported any **CATEGORY TWO** hours for the year 2002, I had posted enough of those hours for the years 2003 and 2004 – *specifically, 98* - that submitting 2002 records would not be necessary. I thank you for making that calculation.

During that same conversation, you calculated that I did not report enough **CATEGORY ONE** hours, which is to say the *sixty* hours required by Title 21 and, based on the record you had in front of you, the deficiency was some *twenty-nine* hours. I am not sure exactly what record you were reading from, but I am sending you the complete record of my **CATEGORY ONE** hours from the years 2002-2004, which you will see, adds up to some *ninety* hours.

Therefore, recalculating the CME hours I posted for those years – less Category Two for 2002- adds up to 188 hours, more than sixty of which are in Category One. I hope this will allow the Board to dismiss the very distressing charges of my violating Title 21. To that end, I hereby give my permission for the legal department of the North Carolina Medical Board, i.e., you, to present my records to the Board and perhaps through an *ex parte* action, have the charges dismissed.

Thank you for your efforts and your interest, Mr Jimison.

IN RE: Reporting of continuing Medical Education requirements

Dear Dr Moffatt:

I received a call from your Marcus Jimison to inform me that certain **charges** had been, or were about to be, lodged against my North Carolina medical license, # 19035, for failure to comply with North Carolina regulation **Title 21, Chapter 32, North Carolina Medical Board, Subchapter 32R, Section .0101** (hereinafter incorporated by reference) which reads, in part "...*(e)ach person licensed to practice medicine...shall complete no less than 150 hours of practice-relevant CME every three years...(of which) at least 60 hours shall be in the...educational provider-initiated category (Credit 1) ...with the remaining hours, if any, in the physician-initiated category (Credit 2).* Mr Jimison also informed me that a hearing concerning these charges was scheduled for mid-February, with the aim of disciplinary action against me and my license should I not respond or fail to appear.

Upon a more careful – and, admittedly, belated - reading of the Title 21 and an extensive review of my professional activities for the past three years concerning the types of CME specified therein, including, but not limited to, *teaching (professional, patient/public health), mentoring, study of community health problems*, I find that I can document more than enough Credit 2 hours, which, when added to the Credit 1 hours I have already reported, should easily qualify for the minimum 150 hours.

For the past years, I have spent considerable time at my home hospital, my own surgery center (fully-accredited), Stanford University and the offices of other private physicians in teaching, coaching, mentoring and precepting surgeons learning new(er) procedures, including, but not limited to, TVT (Gynecare Corp), SPARC, HerOption® endometrial cryoablation, MONARC® (AMS, Minnetonka, MN) and all of the procedures of AGES (my personal acronym for Advanced Gynecologic Endoscopic Surgery) and I have recorded on the NC CME reporting form each and every instance of such teaching and mentoring, with the times, if anything being ‘down-coded’, that is to say, I spent *at least* as much time as I took credit for. If you wish, I will be happy to send documentation for my relationship with the companies mentioned. Also, if it is necessary, the physicians mentioned in my documentation – including Stanford University professors - are prepared to sign affidavits attesting their personal witness to the truth of the activities I have reported. I emphasize that each and all of these ‘teaching and mentoring’ activities were *my teaching and mentoring* of other physicians.



In the packet you are receiving, please also find photographic documentation of my professional visit to Baghdad, Iraq in July and August of 2003, immediately after ground combat was 'finished' and the area was 'secure'. While in the capital city, I gave six lectures at the (Saddam Hussein) Medical College and numerous surgical demonstrations of new(er) techniques of correction of stress urinary incontinence (photos included) while dodging the ground fire, random mortar attack occasional IED of the enemy and the 'friendly fire' from my own countrymen (see photo of US Army helicopter gunship). Should it please the Board, I will send documentation of my Iraq activities with statements from active-duty US Army personnel and will also send copies of my passport stamped (in and out) at the Iraqi-Jordanian border crossing.

Although I cannot be sure what happened to the letters Mr Jimison sent, I apologize for having required the Board to take its time to deal with my CME issues at the level to which it has risen. I have attempted to organize my CME activities as best I could, using the records available and from now on, will document contemporaneously for ease of inspection.

Please review my records and satisfy yourself of my claim for over 200 CME hours for the time period 2003-2005 (with over the required sixty in Category One) and please advise me of additional records or documentation needed. If necessary, as I have in the past, I will be happy to appear at any hearing the Board may desire; although I appreciate Mr Jimison's advising me to obtain North Carolina counsel, if I must appear before the Board, I wish to represent myself. Please understand that my seeming arrogance in acting *in propria persona* is not out of the deluded belief that I possess better legal skills than an attorney, but to my firm belief that I possess a far better memory for, not to mention infinitely more interest in, my own case than any attorney.
