STANDING CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER SMALL CLAIM APPEALS FROM MUNICIPAL COURT

\*\*IMPORTANT\*\* PLEASE READ THIS ORDER CAREFULLY. It contains important information about your case. Failure to comply with any instructions provided in this Order may cause you to lose your case.

- 1. ARBITRATION: Notice of your de novo Compulsory Arbitration hearing date in the Court of Common Pleas will be sent to you within sixty (60) days.
- 2. MEDIATION: You may also be selected for a special mediation conference prior to your arbitration hearing.
- 3. SUPERSEDEAS: This Civil Electronic Filing System shall provide electronic notice of the filing of this appeal to the Municipal Court Administrator. In order to obtain a supersedeas (i.e. a stay of enforcement of the Municipal Court Judgment until the appeal is decided) the Municipal Court Administrator must receive a copy of this appeal.
- 4. SERVICE: As the party taking this appeal, you must serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this Standing Case Management Order on the opposing party. SERVICE must be made upon the opposing party pursuant to Philadelphia Rule of Civil Procedure 1001 (d). You are required to file proof of service promptly upon completion of service utilizing the Civil Electronic Filing System.

The Court will not hear your case and may dismiss your appeal if proper service is not completed and if proof of service is not filed.

5. PLAINTIFFS: If you were the Plaintiff in the Municipal Court (the moving party), and you filed this appeal, or you have been served a copy of this appeal, you must then file a complaint in conformity with the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure, along with a Notice to Defend and Proof of Service.



Filing of the Municipal Court Statement of Claim is not in conformity with the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure.

The Complaint, Notice to Defend and Proof of Service must be filed utilizing the Civil Electronic Filing System within twenty (20) days after service of a Rule to File Complaint.

Failure to timely file your complaint may result in the appeal being dismissed for lack of prosecution pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1037 (a). In addition, if you fail to file a complaint by the time the case is called to trial, the Court can enter a non suit on the motion of the defendant or a non pros on the Court's own motion pursuant to Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 218.

6. **DEFENDANTS:** If you were the defendant in Municipal Court, and you filed this appeal, or have been served with a Notice of Appeal and a complaint, you must file your answer or preliminary objections to the complaint within the time limits provided in the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure.

Failure to file an answer within the required time may result in a judgment being entered against you pursuant to Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure 1037(b).

7. PLEADINGS: Pleadings are limited to complaints; answers; a replies, if the answer contains new matter and/or a counterclaim; counter replies, if the reply to a counterclaim contains new matter; and preliminary objections.

Your case will not be continued to allow additional time for filing pleadings which should have been filed prior to the trial date.

- 8. CONTINUANCES: All applications for continuances shall be reviewed by the Arbitration Center, 1880 John F. Kennedy Blvd., 5th Floor, Philadelphia, PA 19103, pursuant to Philadelphia Civil Rule \*1303(c). Arbitration continuance applications must be filed utilizing the First Judicial District's Electronic Filing System.
- 9. FILINGS OF PETITIONS AND MOTIONS: All petitions, motions and responses must be prepared in compliance with Philadelphia Rule of Civil Procedure 206.1 and 208.3 and filed utilizing the First Judicial District's Electronic Filing System.
