CONSENT ORDER

The Department of Professional Regulation by John M. Goldberg, one of its attorneys, and Giles Mizock, M.D., Respondent, hereby agree to the following:

STIPULATIONS

Giles Mizock, M.D. is licensed as a Physician and Surgeon in the State of Illinois, holding license No. 36-035966. At all times material to the matter set forth in this Consent Order, the Department of Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois had jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties herein.

Information has come to the attention of the Department that Respondent failed to diagnose a twin gestation.

The allegation(s) as set forth herein, if proven to be true would constitute grounds for suspending or revoking Respondent's license as a Physician and Surgeon, on the authority of 225 Illinois Compiled Statutes (1992), 60/22(A)(4).

As a result of the foregoing allegation(s), the Department held an Informal Conference at the offices of the Department, 100 West Randolph Street, Suite 9-300, Chicago, Illinois 60601 on December 3, 1997. Respondent appeared in person on that date,

represented by Robert Butzow. Virgil Wikoff appeared as a member of the Medical Disciplinary Board of the State of Illinois and John M. Goldberg appeared as an attorney for the Department.

Respondent has presented evidence that even though his failure to diagnose the twin gestation did not constitute gross negligence he no longer practices obstetrics.

Respondent has been advised of the right to have the pending allegation(s) reduced to written charges, the right to a hearing, the right to contest any charges brought, and the right to administrative review of any Order resulting from a hearing. Respondent knowingly waives each of these rights, as well as any right to administrative review of this Consent Order.

Respondent and the Department have agreed, in order to resolve this matter, that Giles Mizock, M.D. be permitted to enter into a Consent Order with the Department, providing for the imposition of disciplinary measures which are fair and equitable in the circumstances and which are consistent with the best interests of the people of the State of Illinois.

CONDITTIONS

WHEREFORE, the Department, through John M. Goldberg, its attorney, and Giles Mizock, M.D., agree:

A. Respondent shall receive a Reprimand by operation of this Consent Order. Respondent agrees that his practice of medicine will not include obstetrics.

- B. Any violation by Respondent of the terms and conditions of this Consent Order shall be grounds for the Department to immediately file a Complaint to revoke the Respondent's license to practice as a Physician and Surgeon in the State of Illinois.
- C. This Consent Order shall become effective upon approval by the Director of the Department.
