NOTICE:

Title 26, Vermont Statutes Annotated, §1400, RENEWAL OF LICENSE

(a) Every person licensed to practice medicine and surgery by the state board of medical registration shall apply biennially for the renewal of his license. Before January 1 of each biennial year, the secretary of the medical registration board shall send to each licensee a license renewal application form and a notice that the existing license will expire on the next January 31. The licensee shall file his application for license renewal and pay a renewal fee of \$5.00 before the latter date. The secretary shall register the applicant and issue the renewal license. Before February 15 of the biennial year, the secretary shall pay the license renewal fees into the state treasury and shall file a list of registrants with the secretary of state.

(b) A person who practices medicine and surgery and who fails to renew his license in accordance with the provisions of this section shall be deemed an illegal practitioner and shall forfeit the right to so practice—.

(c) Any person who allows his license to lapse by failing to renew the same—may be reinstated by the board by payment of the renewal fee with an additional \$10.00 penalty.
