Korle Bu Teaching Hospital (KBTH) is a large public hospital in Accra, Ghana. With a 2000-bed capacity and 17 clinical units, it is the largest referral hospital in Ghana, and the third-largest hospital in Africa.

The Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at KBTH consists of over 20 faculty and over 50 residents from several West African Countries. The Labor and Delivery Ward conducts approximately 12,000 deliveries per year.

The respective Departments of Obstetrics and Gynecology of NYU and KBTH have formed an academic partnership in order to provide educational and research opportunities for students, residents and faculty.
