## Services we provide

#### Gynecological services

- · Breast and pelvic exams
- Pap smears and treatment of abnormal paps
- · Fibroid management
- Abnormal bleeding
- · Gynecological surgeries

# Family planning counseling and all birth control methods, including

- Same-day placement of intrauterine devices (IUDs) and hormonal implants
- Permanent birth control for women, and counseling and referrals for men
- Emergency contraception (also called Plan B, or "the morning after pill")

# Screening and treatment for most sexually transmitted infections

- HIV, syphilis, chlamydia, gonorrhea, human papillomavirus
- Cryotherapy for genital warts and cervical abnormalities

#### Obstetrics services

- Regular checkups throughout pregnancy
- Women deliver their babies at Ronald Reagan UCLA Medical Center
- · Availability of OB/GYN physicians and nurse midwives

#### High-risk obstetric services

 Sophisticated diagnostic tools and treatments to ensure the health of mother and baby for women with complicated pregnancies

#### Miscarriage management and abortion services

- Management of pregnancy loss
- Medication and surgical abortion
- Pregnancy terminations for patients with complex medical conditions

#### Pelvic pain clinic

 Treatment of women with chronic pelvic, vaginal and vulvar pain

#### Teen services

- Adolescents and teens can receive confidential, quality medical care free of cost through the Family PACT program
- California law protects minors' rights to access reproductive and sexual health services without consent of parent or guardian
- California schools are required to allow students to leave during the school day in order to receive confidential health services without notifying parents



# **Directions & parking**

UCLA OB/GYN Clinic is located in the West Medical Building in the heart of Westwood Village, near Ronald Reagan UCLA Medical Center. The clinic is accessible by public transit.

From the 405 freeway, exit Wilshire Blvd. East (toward Westwood). Turn left (North) on Veteran Ave. Turn right on Kinross Ave, and then take your first left into parking structure #32.

Park in a numbered space, and pay at the machines located at the lot exits. The West Medical Building is located directly behind the parking lot, with its entrance on the west side, facing the courtyard.
