Plaintiff, above named, complaining of the Defendants herein, through her attorneys, Meagher & Meagher, P.C., upon information and belief, alleges as follows:

AS AND FOR A FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION

FIRST:

The Plaintiff's-Decedent, FATIMATA ZONGO, died on

November 28, 2015.

SECOND:

Prior hereto on July 28, 2017, Letters of Administration were

issued by the Surrogate of the County of Westchester to the Plaintiff herein, ADJARATOU ZONGO, and said Letters of Administration are still in full force and effect.

THIRD:

At all times relevant hereinafter mentioned, Plaintiff,

ADJARATOU ZONGO, was and is a resident of the County of Westchester, at 108 Jefferson Street, City of Yonkers, State of New York.

FOURTH:

At all times hereinafter mentioned, the Defendant, DMITRY

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GERBER, (hereinafter referred to as, "GERBER"), was a physician licensed to practice medicine and practicing medicine in the State of New York.

FIFTH: At all times hereinafter mentioned, the Defendant, JOHN ILARIO, (hereinafter referred to as, "ILARIO"), was a physician licensed to practice medicine and practicing medicine in the State of New York.

THIRTY-FIFTH: During the year 2015, and more specifically in November, 2015, the Defendant, KHAN, provided medical care and treatment to the Plaintiff-Decedent, FATIMATA ZONGO.

During the year 2015, and more specifically from April, THIRTY-SIXTH: 2015 through November, 2015, the Defendant, WESTMED, provided medical care and treatment to the Plaintiff-Decedent, FATIMATA ZONGO.

During the year 2015, and more specifically from THIRTY-SEVENTH:

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April, 2015 through November, 2015, the Defendant, OB/GYN ASSOCIATES, provided medical care and treatment to the Plaintiff-Decedent, FATIMATA ZONGO.

THIRTY-EIGHTH: During the year 2015, and more specifically from April, 2015 through November, 2015, the Defendant, ST. JOHN'S, provided medical care and treatment to the Plaintiff-Decedent, FATIMATA ZONGO.

THIRTY-NINTH: As a result of the medical care, treatment or lack thereof rendered to the Plaintiff-Decedent, FATIMATA ZONGO, by the Defendants herein, one, some, or all of them, their agents, servants, and/or employees, their departures from accepted standards of medical, hospital, and other good practices, the Plaintiff-Decedent, FATIMATA ZONGO, sustained severe, serious, permanent personal injuries and subsequent death.

FORTIETH: Plaintiff-Decedent's injuries were caused due to the carelessness, negligence, including negligent hiring, retaining, supervising, and credentialing, and departures from accepted and proper medical, hospital, gynecological, obstetrical and other good practices on the part of the Defendants herein, one, some, or all of them, their agents, servants, and/or employees in the care and the treatment or lack thereof that was rendered and tendered to the Plaintiff-Decedent herein, for the period of time she was under the care of the Defendants herein, whereby she incurred pain and suffering and other financial losses without any fault contributing thereto by her.

FORTY-FIRST: This action falls within one or more exceptions set forth in the Civil Practice Laws and Rules Section 1602.

FORTY-SECOND: As a result of such injuries, pain and suffering, and other financial losses, the Plaintiff-Decedent, FATIMATA ZONGO, was caused to suffer damages in an amount of money that exceeds the monetary jurisdiction of all other courts.

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AS AND FOR A SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION

Plaintiff repeats, reiterates, and re-alleges each and every FORTY-THIRD: allegation set forth in the FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION inclusive with the same force and effect as if more fully set forth herein.

The Defendants herein, one, some, or all of them, their FORTY-FOURTH: agents, servants, and/or employees, failed to disclose all of the facts that a reasonable doctor or health care personnel under such circumstances would explain to a patient, including a failure to disclose the risks and benefits of various courses of treatment, the alternatives thereto and the risks and benefits relating to the alternatives and otherwise failed to properly, adequately and fully inform the patient.

That a reasonable and prudent person in the FORTY-FIFTH: Plaintiff-Decedent's position would not have undergone the course of treatment prescribed if she had been fully informed, and that the lack of informed consent is a proximate cause of pain and suffering and other financial losses for which recovery is sought.

As a result of the foregoing lack of informed consent, the FORTY-SIXTH: Plaintiff's-Decedent, FATIMATA ZONGO, and Plaintiff herein, ADJARATOU ZONGO, as Proposed Administratrix of the Estate and next of kin, suffered damages in an amount of money that exceeds the jurisdictional limits of all other Courts.

AND AS FOR A THIRD CAUSE OF ACTION

Plaintiff repeats, reiterates and re-alleges each and FORTY-SEVENTH: every allegation set forth in the FIRST and SECOND CAUSES OF ACTION with the same force and effect as if more fully set forth herein.

The aforesaid death of the Plaintiff's-Decedent, FORTY-EIGHTH: FATIMATA ZONGO, was due to the carelessness, negligence, abandonment and/or departures from INDEX NO. 61347/2017

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accepted and proper medical, hospital, and other good practices on the part of the Defendants herein, one some, or all of them, their agents, servants and/or employees, in the care and treatment or lack thereof that was rendered to the decedent herein, without any negligence on her part contributing thereto

At the time of death of the Plaintiff's-Decedent herein, the FORTY-NINTH: decedent left surviving her sister, ADJARATOU ZONGO, and other next of kin, including a daughter,

Leila Otujo, who suffered pecuniary and other losses as a result of her death.

FIFTIETH:

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As a result of the aforesaid, the Plaintiff herein,

ADJARATOU ZONGO, and other next of kin, including a daughter, Leila Otujo, have been damaged in sums of money which exceed the monetary jurisdiction of all other courts.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, ADJARATOU ZONGO, as Administratrix of the Estate of FATIMATA ZONGO, Deceased, and ADJARATOU ZONGO, Individually, demands judgment against the Defendants herein, one, some, or all of them, in sums of money that exceed the monetary jurisdiction of all other Courts in the FIRST, SECOND and THIRD CAUSES OF ACTION, in an amount of money that exceeds the monetary jurisdiction of all other Courts, together with interest, costs, attorney's fees and disbursements of this action.
