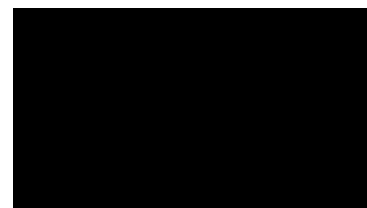
Biography
