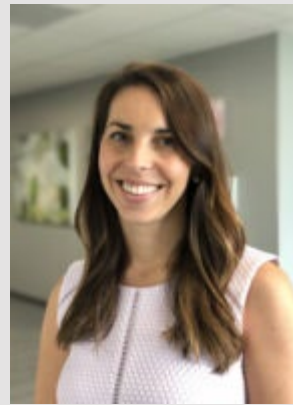

Ranked among the top women's health fellowships, the Washington University Maternal-Fetal Medicine fellowship prepares trainees to achieve excellence in academic medicine.



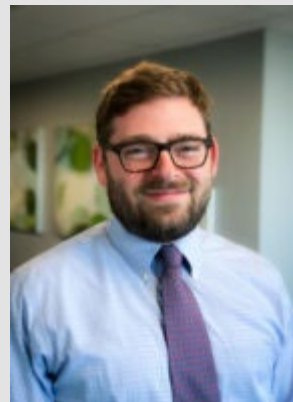

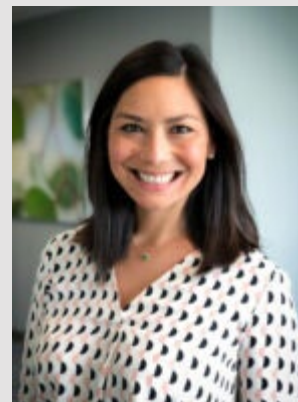

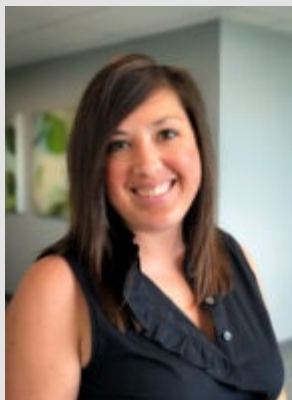

## Reproductive Endocrinology & Infertility

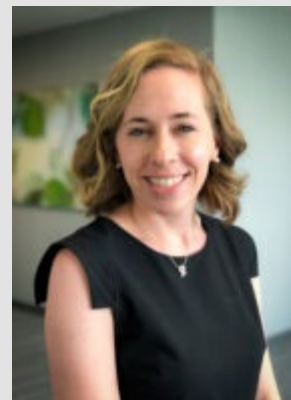
