Fellowship in Family Planning

The Fellowship in Family Planning is a two-year post-residency program offered by the **Division of Family Planning**. The fellowship focuses on research, teaching, and clinical practice to develop future leaders with expertise in family planning.

Under close mentorship, fellows receive hands-on training in patient care and clinical research, develop clinical and teaching skills, and connect to a national network of family planning experts. During the two-year program, fellows will pursue either a **Master of Science in Clinical Investigation** or a **Master of Population Health Sciences**. Fellows also have the opportunity to complete a global health rotation.

Fellows receive a PGY 5/6 salary, health insurance and tuition.

Our fellows develop outstanding clinical skills and exceptional teaching abilities while

making meaningful contributions to clinical research.
