OBSTETRICS & GYNECOLOGY RESIDENCY ROTATION LOCATIONS

HAHNEMANN UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL

Hahnemann University Hospital is a 500+ bed



university hospital located in

Center City Philadelphia. This facility includes departmental offices, resident facilities, redecoration and outfitting of labor and delivery and postpartum, new operating room equipment for gynecologic surgery and incorporation into the rest of the clinical services in the institution. Additionally, there are new family waiting facilities, a 20-bed neonatal intensive care unit, an 8-bed private postpartum suite, an expanded labor and delivery area with seven rooms and three new triage rooms. There are two main operating suites available to the residents in this institution: the short procedure unit (SPU), an eightroom complete-day-stay-type OR, and the 8th-floor OR, a 12-room intensive main operating room suite. There are two main intensive care areas as well as complete medical and surgical floors. The main residents' continuity practice is located on this campus. This serves as the primary inpatient facility for the residency program.

HOSPITAL

Residents cover the OR cases at both hospitals. The residents review the cases in the holding area, write a preop note assessment and greet the patients. They first assist on all of the cases, write post-op orders and round on the patient post-op. Gynecology consults on the floor and in the ER are done by the resident with the faculty present and involved. The residents also respond to night call emergency OR needs at the two facilities, usually for surgical treatment of ectopic pregnancies. The attending makes the assessment for OR need and subsequently calls the resident in to first assist on the case. The hospital is within five miles from the center city campus.

VIRTUA MEMORIAL HOSPITAL

Virtua Memorial Hospital is a tertiary care regional hospital located in Mount



Laurel, New Jersey, about 16 miles from the center city location of Hahnemann. Residents rotate there as part of the in-patient service on general obstetrics and gynecology. Residents cover the services with in-house attendings.

BRYN MAWR HOSPITAL/MAIN LINE FERTILITY

While at Bryn Mawr Hospital/Main Line Fertility, senior residents rotate through the private offices (Paoli, Bryn Mawr, Oaks) of Main Line Fertility. Residents participate in clinical care of infertility and gynecologic endocrinology patients. During this rotation, residents participate in all procedures pertinent to this area of the obstetrics and gynecology residency program, working side by side with the attending physician. They participate in clinical patient evaluation, IVF stimulation protocols, ultrasonographic and endocrine evaluation of congenital adrenal hyperplasia, controlled ovarian hyperstimulation, IUI and hysteroscopic and hysterosalpingography techniques. Residents are under the direct supervision of 4 different reproductive endocrinology/infertility (REI) specialists, and thus are exposed to different approaches to the management of infertility. At the end of this rotation, the senior resident presents to the department, in a grand rounds format, a topic in REI and "my 3 more interesting cases," which s/he

prepares under the supervision of Dr. Blasco, the REI director.

WOMEN'S CARE CENTER

The Women's Care Center makes high-quality gynecologic care available to all women. Whether you're a student on the go, a working mother or a senior with multiple health care needs, the Women's Care Center serves as a one-stop shop for the general wellness and specialty care you need. In addition, the Women's Care Center provides services to men, including rapid HIV testing and sexually transmitted infection testing, counseling and treatment. Residents rotate in this ambulatory site for their continuity practice. They are supervised by the faculty of the department and the Ryan Foundation faculty.

PLANNED PARENTHOOD OF SOUTH EASTERN PENNSYLVANIA

Planned Parenthood of South Eastern Pennsylvania is located about six blocks from our center city location. Residents rotate through this facility during their ambulatory rotations to learn all methods of reproductive management.
