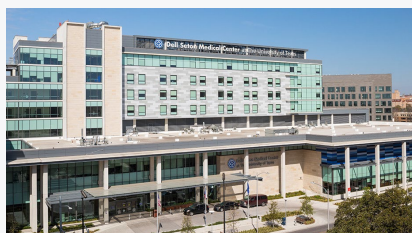

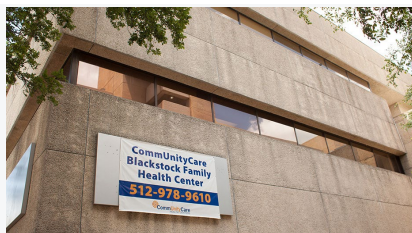
### Dell Seton Medical Center at The University of Texas

CommUnityCare operates a large network of Federally Qualified Health Centers providing affordable and culturally competent primary and specialty care throughout the greater Austin area. Resident physicians provide complex obstetrical and gynecologic care at three consultative and referral sites for surrounding low-risk clinics within the network.



## Women's Health Institute at UT Health Austin

UT Health Austin, the clinical practice of Dell Med, uses a revolutionary team-based practice model that takes a multidisciplinary approach to treating people with complex medical conditions. Current specialty areas include vulvar disorders, chronic pelvic pain and pelvic floor disorders, with complex contraceptive, reproductive loss and gynecologic oncology care clinics in development.

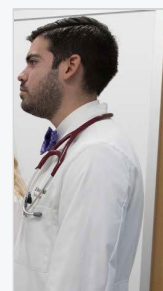
