The Obstetrics and Gynecology Residency program at Dell Medical School is a fully accredited, four-year training program designed to deliver knowledge and experiences to residents that prepare them for a career as a specialist in general obstetrics and gynecology or subspecialty fellowship training.

UT Health Austin, the clinical practice of Dell Med, uses a revolutionary team-based practice model that takes a multidisciplinary approach to treating people with complex medical conditions. Current specialty areas include vulvar disorders, chronic pelvic pain and pelvic floor disorders, with complex contraceptive, reproductive loss and gynecologic oncology care clinics in development.
