I am pleased to offer you a reappointment in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine and Public Health as a Clinical Adjunct Associate Professor beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2021.

This appointment will be reviewed for continuation prior to June 30, 2021.
