# OB/GYN Residency Special Features

## Global Women's Health Elective

OBGyn Residents at Maimonides Medical Center have the opportunity to participate in Global Women's Health Elective at Kapenguria Teaching Hospital in West Pocket, Kenya during their chief year of residency and Santiago Atitlan, Guatemala during their third year.

### Included In The Global Women's Health Elective

- Clinical services: Labor & Delivery, Gynecologic Surgery, Reproductive Health/Family Planning
- Training with local groups on PPH prevention and intervention, preeclampsia and diabetes
- Conduct ultrasound assessment for local residents at health clinics

At the end of the rotation residents will be asked to fill out a feedback form and write for the MOG newsletter describing their experiences.

## Ryan Program

The Kenneth J. Ryan Residency Training Program in Abortion and Family Planning was started at Maimonides in 2016. Residents rotate one-on-one with the Director of Family Planning for 4-week blocks in both their 2nd and 3rd years. All residents rotate, but the level of participation is discussed before the rotation begins to be respectful of individual resident wishes.
