Gynecologic Oncology - Apr 2010

Objective: To examine whether overweight and obesity could lead to increased endometrial proliferation and activation of AKT and ERKL2 in cycling premenopausal women.

Methods: Endometrial and blood samples were obtained from women with normal endometrial histology, and allocated into three groups—normal-weight, overweight and obese—according to the subject's body mass index (BMI). Samples from obese patients with type—I endometrial cancer (EC) were included as a control.
