## Meet the Robotic Surgeons

**[Satyan K. Shah, M.D.](#)** - Dr. Shah is a Urologic Oncologist and Director of Robotic Surgery at UNM Hospitals. His practice focuses on robotic and laparoscopic treatments for patients with prostate and kidney cancer. He graduated Alpha Omega Alpha from UMDNJ-Robert Wood Johnson Medical School and completed a fellowship in Minimally Invasive and Robotic Urologic Oncology at Roswell Park Cancer Institute in New York.

**Anthony Smith, M.D.** - Dr. Smith is Professor and Chief of the Division of Urology at UNM. He has extensive experience in open and laparoscopic Urologic Oncology, especially bladder and kidney cancer. He is also Director of the Urology Residency Program at UNM.

**Michael Davis, M.D.** - Dr. Davis is Associate Professor of Surgery (Urology) and is a fellowship trained Urologic Oncologist. His clinical interests include Urologic Oncology, Renal Transplant, Laparoscopy, Endourology, and urological prosthetics. He is also the Surgical Director of the Renal Transplant program at UNM.

**Rebecca G. Rogers, MD** - Dr. Rogers is Director, Division of Urogynecology as well as the Director of the Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery Fellowship at the University of New Mexico. Dr. Rogers graduated from Harvard Medical School, and completed her residency and fellowship in Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery at the University of New Mexico.

**Yuko Komesu, MD** - Dr. Komesu completed her fellowship in Female Pelvic Medicine and Reconstructive Surgery in 2006, and joined Dr. Rogers that year at the University of New Mexico. Although new to the University, Dr. Komesu has a long history of providing care to New Mexicans, and previously worked at Lovelace Health Systems. Dr. Komesu graduated from University of Michigan medical school, and completed her residency there.
