### Reproductive Health Care and Advocacy

The Reproductive Health Care and Advocacy Fellowship is a year-long program that develops family medicine leaders who provide, teach, and advocate for reproductive care.

**Four out of five people in the United States receive their health care from a primary care provider. More than 6% of family medicine residency programs provide training in early pregnancy loss. Our fellowship program helps fill this training gap.**

Launched in 2007, the fellowship program has trained 28 family physicians, creating change across the country. Fellows are chosen because of their interest in being an abortion provider shortage area, developing new abortion training sites, or being an abortion provider. Fellows spend one year as a “trainer in a provider shortage area” providing procedures related to contraception and miscarriage care and learning from experienced providers. Fellows also participate in a variety of leadership development and advocacy activities during their fellowship year.

We started out training just one fellow per year. With donations from individuals and a grant from the Horace W. Goldsmith Foundation, we have been able to increase the number of fellows we train to five fellows a year at sites in Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, and Washington state. But, we can do more. Help us achieve our goal of training family physicians to become skilled providers and advocates for expanding access to reproductive health care.
