 CURTIS EVANS STOVER, M.D., 61,
 of Little Rock, husband of Joni
 Roberts Stover, died Monday, Feb.
 25, 2002. He was
 born in Little Rock
 to Curtis and Elsie
 Evans Stover and
 after graduation
 from Little Rock
 Central High School
 he entered the
 United States



Army. He was a graduate of the Uni-
 versity of Arkansas at Fayetteville and
 received his Doctorate in Medicine
 from UAMS, serving his internship at
 St. Elizabeth Hospital in Dayton, Ohio.
 After practicing for two years in New
 Brennan, Ohio, he started a practice in
 Arkadelphia.

Dr. Stover and his wife, Joni, were
 dedicated activists in the pro-choice
 movement. In 1981 he moved to Little
 Rock, where he founded the Little
 Rock Family Planning Clinic from
 which he retired in 1999, but he and
 Joni continued to be activists for
 women's rights. In the late 1970s, he
 became a self-taught computer pro-
 grammer and designed billing pro-
 grams for professionals. He was a
 member of the Arkansas Medical As-
 sociation, the National Abortion Fed-
 eration, the American Civil Liberties
 Union and charter member of the Na-
 tional Coalition of Abortion Providers.

He is survived by his wife of 20
 years; two sons, Ronnie Stover of Lit-
 tle Rock, and Eddie Stover of New Or-
 leans; a sister, Marie Duncan and her
 husband, John, and a brother-in-law,
 John Jacobsen all of Jacksonville; and
 numerous nieces and nephews. Curtis
 will be missed by a host of family
 and friends.
