We believe that every woman should have access to a wide range of family planning options, and deserves an individualized consultation to help her make this decision.

Our faculty has expertise in treating such conditions as vaginitis, vulvar pain, and abnormal uterine bleeding. Our patients' ages range from adolescence to menopause, and we are happy to treat women with other medical conditions that affect their gynecological health.

## Services We Provide:

#### Family Planning:

We offer a full range of options for birth control and family planning. These include:

- · Hormonal contraception and non-hormonal contraceptive methods
- Contraceptive implants
- Intra-uterine devices IUDs
- Sterilization including tubal ligation and hysteroscoic sterilization
- Emergency contraception
- Pregnancy options counseling
- · Management of miscarriage and unintended pregnancy
- Family planning clinic for women with complicated medical problems
- Variety of analgesic and anesthesia options for all procedures
