Dr. Katia T. Laremont, age 50, died unexpectedly on June 22, 2014, at her home in Palm Beach Gardens, FL. Dr. Laremont was born April 23, 1964 in Panama City, Panama to Earl and Claire Greaves (Laremont Smith). Katia graduated from Silver Creek Central School in 1983 and earned her Bachelor's degree from Johns Hopkins University in 1987. She completed her Medical School training at the University of Buffalo, in 1991. She then completed her Ob-Gyn residency at the Greater Baltimore Medical Center, an affiliate of Johns Hopkins. Dr. Laremont was a board certified fellow of the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology and in 2001 opened Village Women's Health Care with the personal mission of providing compassionate and innovative patient care with a personalized touch. Dr. Laremont was a member of the Palm Beach County Medical Association, the T. Leroy Jefferson Medical Society and the American Urogynecology Association. She was an active member of St. Juliana Catholic Church and was Vice-President of the Council of Catholic Women. Katia enjoyed playing golf with her husband and running in her spare time, and recently completed half marathon with the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society Team in Training. She is survived by her husband, Herman Walker, her adoptive father James E. Smith of West Palm Beach, FL, her sisters Liza (Jon A.) Smith of Silver Creek, NY, Dr. Raquel Schmidt (Jari Wallach) of Buffalo, NY, and her niece Claire Smith of Buffalo, NY. She was predeceased in 2009 by her mother Claire Laremont Smith. Funeral services will be held on 10 a.m., Monday, June 30, at St Juliana Catholic Church.
