About Ryan Montoya, M.D.

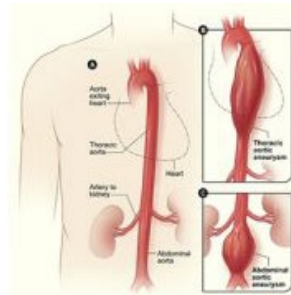
