OCTOBER 12, 1985 The Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners filed a formal Complaint against Dr. Modaber based on action taken against his medical license in the state of Virginia. copies; Complaint w/ exhibits 14 pages OCTOBER 30, 1985 The Board entered into a Stipulation for Settlement with Dr. Modaber and it was Ordered that he perform no abortion procedures, no obstetrical deliveries, and that his obstetrical practice be limited to prenatal care through the end of the second trimester at which time the patient shall transfer to another OBGYN, and that he perform no surgical gynecological procedures. Dr. Modaber shall also obtain additional medical training, 500

hours of CME, and pass the specialty board certification written exam. copies; Stipulation for Settlement 4 pages, Order 5 pages
