A doctor's receptionist has been charged with practicing medicine without a license by injecting abortion-inducing drugs into three patients, Ocean County authorities said yesterday. The receptionist, Liza Berdiel, 24, who worked for Dr. Flavius Thompson at Pleasant Woman's Pavilion in Lakewood, was charged with conducting three abortions in November and December, according to the complaint.
