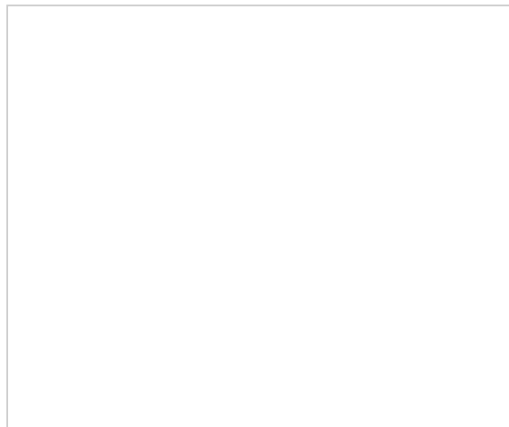
About Dr. Kathryn Storck, MD
